On 28 July 2020 the European Commission (EC) adopted a Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2020/1500 on the applicability of Directive 2014/25/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council to contracts awarded for activities related to production and wholesale of electricity in Lithuania. The EC Decision provides that Directive 2014/25/EU does not apply to contracts awarded by contracting entities the purpose of which is to enable the production and wholesale of electricity from conventional energy sources and renewable energy sources in Lithuania, except for the production and wholesale of electricity produced from renewable energy sources and which is subject to the first and second subsidy schemes. Pursuant to this Decision, procurements of contracting entities engaged in the production and/or wholesale of electricity for the performance of such activities are not subject to the provisions of the LP. The exception may apply to other Group companies that carry out electricity generation and/or wholesale activities and that are not involved in the subsidy schemes described in the exception.
